"Imagine the hospital you would like for you, your family and friends... Imagine a hospital with state-of-the-art equipment, with sufficient space to meet patient volumes, now and into the future, and designed to meet the needs of patients and staff.... A facility that would attract and retain the finest medical and professional staff—a key to a healthy community".

These were the words in the video debuted at the launch of the \$20 million Heart & Soul Campaign on October 30th to a main lobby packed by donors, volunteers, hospital staff, doctors and the community.

The event celebrated major gifts to date, including a \$5 million pledge from the City of Stratford, \$1 million dollar pledge from the Hospital Auxiliary Association of the Stratford General Hospital, \$1.5 million from the Yeandle Family, \$625,000 from Perth East, \$500,000 from the County of Perth, \$400,000 from West Perth over \$242,000 from Perth South, \$200,000 from Stratford Rotary Club and other lead gifts from service clubs and individuals.

Honourary Chair Cynthia Dale sang in tribute to these major donors and that of the thousands of other donors who have already given from their hearts, saluting their support for the campaign with a heart-warming rendition of Born to Live accompanied on piano by Laura Burton.

Bill Preston, Campaign Co-chair unveiled the curtained banner with a flourish and announced the \$20 million dollar goal to the applause of the audience.

Members of the campaign cabinet were commended for taking up the challenge to raise the \$20 million local share needed for state-of-the-art technology and a modern facility. Our donors are a critical component in ensuring we have a state-of-the-art facility and equipment. Andrea Page, Foundation executive director says donors are the very "heart and soul" of the fundraising effort and have helped us already raise \$13.5 million in cash pledges towards the goal.



Did You Know:

- From cancer surgeries, to hip & knees, from the critically ill to the emergency case, our hospital is doing more and more every year. some 50,000 patients a year will be impacted by our redevelopment project.
- Within the next year, it's likely that you or someone you care about will be visiting our Emergency Department. From caring for a sick child, to the most serious accidents and injuries, our Emergency Department is our hospital's front line, seeing some 27,000 patients a year from throughout the region.
- By working together we can help ensure our hospital is second to none for the care, expertise and compassion they provide 24/7.
- New Operating Rooms will be a "cut above" the current O.R. which is undersized for the number of surgeons, volume of patients and new technologies. Imagine Operating Rooms where surgeons can control equipment using voice activated and touch screen technologies. CT and ultrasound images are at the O.R. team's fingertips displayed on flat screens. 2,326 major surgeries performed last year
- Some 570 patients a year need the most intensive care our hospital can provide. The Intensive Care Unit needs to be a place you can count on...whether it be a heart attack, a car accident or severe pneumonia.
- Reducing delays and helping patient flow are key reasons for the expansion and relocation of Medical Imaging to the new North wing, close to Emergency, Intensive Care and Operating Rooms. The Unit will include a breast health centre for women and state of the art digital technology like the PACS system that will revolutionize medical imaging. 20,907 medical imaging visits in one year, 2868 CT scans.
